THE CONSTRUCTION INSPECTOR

Situation:

The work is underway or just completed. The contractor is still on site and the Architect is still under contract.

THE DESIGNER OF REMODEL PROJECTS

Situation:

A non-barrier removal project has triggered barrier removal. The designer is determining the scope of the barrier removal to comply with state code.

TRANSITION PLAN AUTHOR What we're doing

Situation:

Barrier is being evaluated in light of Program Access to determine if its' removal will be a part of the Transition Plan. Primary guide is the ADA Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG).

Three Examples

These examples are illustrative and not meant to be guidelines. Each situation must be judged on its' merits.

THE	1. Side toilet grab bar height.
