Committee Member Valadez reviewed the 2024-25 Annual Report with regard to the Approved Category IV and V Fees.

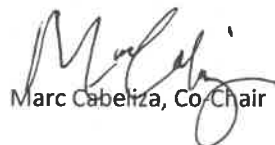
Maritime Integration Fee Decisions

Co-Chair Cabeliza stated there are concerns about the equity of the ASI and University fees and Cal Poly students not receiving services for the fees they are paying. Committee Member Valadez mentioned that Category II fees will be invested from a campus perspective.
