Call to Order/Introductions

Co-Chair Marc Cabeliza called the meeting to order at 10:16 a.m.

Review/Approve Meeting Record

The committee members reviewed the 3/3/26 meeting record and, with no objections, the record was unanimously approved.

Follow-Up Questions – Category II/III Fee (Solano Decisions)

Co-Chair Valadez asked the committee if they had any follow-up questions for Category II/III Fees. Committee Member Drouin inquired how the communications were made to San Luis Obispo and Solano campuses in this regard. Co-Chair Valadez responded that communications were made at Open House and website. Committee Member Murphy added that the staff for the respective departments and programs were notified.

Informational Item: Firefighter Category III Fee

Co-Chair Valadez reviewed the process and needs related to Category III fees with the committee and noted that Category III fees (course fees) have all been removed above \$500 at Solano campus. He mentioned that the Firefighter Category III fee is a unique course since community members attend and the fee is distributed to EPaCE. Committee Member Windokun mentioned that this particular course is essential for students. Committee Member Aguiar inquired if the number of students shown in the materials provided to the committee includes community members. Committee Member Windokun confirmed that it did not include community members. Committee Member Drouin inquired about the acronym EPaCE. Co-Chair Valadez replied that EPaCE stands for Cal Poly Extended, Professional and Continuing Education which provides access to Cal Poly and expands learning opportunities for individuals through a variety of academic and professional programs. Committee Member Drouin inquired about the course requirements. Committee Member Windokun replied that semester courses are completed by graduation as indicated in the catalog. Co-Chair Cabeliza inquired if students at the San Luis Obispo campus are offered the course. Committee Member Windokun mentioned that the course is offered as an in-person class at Solano campus to all Cal Poly students.
