#### **Call to Order**

### Student Success Fee – One-time Funding Requests

Co-Chair Fashami reviewed the guidelines regarding presentations and reminded the committee and guests that the purpose of the Student Success Fee is for students to succeed and that the purpose of the presentations is in regards to one-time funding requests.

#### **Presentations**

Mike Miller, representing Academic Affairs, presented a proposal for Excellence through Project-Based Learn by Doing in the amount of \$100,000. This proposal is in support of helping to fund student projects such as senior projects or theses, travel and expenses associated with participation in student research, group projects, conferences, competitions, equipment and materials related to student research. The funding would help supplement the Baker & Koob Endowments which are currently funding some of these projects.

Julie Bettergarcia, OUDI, presented a proposal for BEACON Research Funding in the amount of \$100,000, which would enable 20 student faculty matches at \$5,000 per match. This proposal would help to support the assistance of underrepresented students by a faculty member on their research endeavors. The program facilitates mentoring skills of faculty who are involved in the program.

Co-Chair Fashami requested that the committee prioritize the proposals and have the dollar amount totaled in order to get organized for the next meeting.

Co-Chair Villa discussed the items that needed follow-up prior to the next meeting.
