- Submit all content pertaining to employee stories to Anthony Rivera.
- Please send all story content in MS Word format.
- Please provide photographs of the employee(s) to support the story.
- All photography submitted must be suitable for printing: high-resolution, 300dpi, full-color photography, jpeq files (larger than 3mb) are preferred.
- Attach the photography to the email, or upload it to the <a href="Employee Profile website">Employee Profile website</a> with the corresponding employee name and campus on the title of the file.
