

GUIDE TO PARKING

AG RESIDENT PERMITS

Only available with an exception from AG Housing.

Your license plate is your permit. It is your responsibility to properly display your permit. If you do not have a front plate, you must park head in to avoid citations.

ANYTIME

- » AG Residential Areas
- » Commuter Lots
- » Outlying Lots

NEVER

- » Residential Areas other than AG residential areas
- » Yellow State Vehicle Space
- » Red Zones, including No Parking zones
- » ADA without a Placard
- » Tech Park
- » Overnight Parking
- » Health Center or Children's Center without Pass and a valid Permit
- » Longer in a timed zone than posted time limit

LIMITED TIME ZONES

- » ParkMobile & Pay By Phone App
- » Are marked with Green curbs; NOT the same as Sponsored Guest Spaces
- » Must purchase additional payment to authorize vehicle to park in these spaces
- » Start your session before leaving your vehicle to avoid citations

ONLY AFTER 5 P.M.

- » Grand Structure
- » Sponsored Guest
- » Staff Spaces, NOT including Staff 24/7 Spaces

RESIDENT PERMIT + ADA PLACARD

- » ADA Spaces
- » Limited Time Zones **without** additional payment; must still have a valid Cal Poly Permit

HELPFUL INFO

- Only one vehicle may be on campus per permit
- A Resident permit can have a motorcycle attached to it, however, a motorcycle permit may NOT have a vehicle on it
- Your license plate must be visible to our LPR (License Plate Recognition) software. If you do not have a front plate, you must park head in
- Parking Garages have 7' Clearance
- No unattended vehicles in loading zones

OUTLYING AREAS:

H1, H13, H14 B/C, H15, Dairy, Poultry, Crops

COMMUTER LOTS:

H12, H14A, H16

RESIDENTIAL AREAS:

Structure 131, R3, & R4
