

GUIDE TO PARKING

TEMPORARY MEDICAL PERMITS

Only available with approval from the DRC (Disability Resource Center)



Important: Linking Your Permit

If approved for a Temporary Medical permit, it is your responsibility to contact TAPS to link permit to your account. This permit is only valid when accompanied by a valid Cal Poly Permit.

ANYTIME

- » Staff locations (NOT including Staff 24/7 locations)
- » Staff locations in Residential Structures
- » Commuter locations (Including Grand Structure)
- » Outlying Lots

NEVER

- » ADA without a Placard
- » Longer in a timed zone than posted time limit
- » 24/7 Spaces
- » Yellow State Vehicle Space
- » Red Zones, including No Parking zones
- » Tech Park
- » Overnight Parking
- » Health Center or Children's Center without Pass and a valid Permit

LIMITED TIME ZONES

- » Must purchase additional payment to authorize vehicle to park in these spaces
- » ParkMobile & Pay By Phone App
- » Are marked with Green curbs; NOT the same as Sponsored Guest Spaces
- » Start your session before leaving your vehicle to avoid citations

ONLY AFTER 5 P.M.

- » Sponsored Guest

CAL POLY PERMIT + ADA PLACARD

- » ADA Spaces
- » Staff Spaces
- » Sponsored Guest Spaces
- » Residential Spaces
- » Limited Time Zones **without** additional payment; must still have a valid Cal Poly Permit

HELPFUL INFO

- DRC Tram service is available to eligible students.
M-F 6:45 a.m. - 7p.m.
M-F 8am - 4:30p.m. (Summer)
- Temporary Medical Permits do NOT authorize you to occupy an ADA space
- Your license plate must be visible to our LPR (License Plate Recognition) software. If you do not have a front plate, you must park head in
- Parking Garages have 7' Clearance
- No unattended vehicles in loading zones

OUTLYING AREAS:

H1, H13, H14 B/C, H15, Dairy, Poultry, Crops

COMMUTER LOTS:

H12, H14A, H16

RESIDENTIAL AREAS:

Structure 131, R3, & R4



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
